Breakfast for Ladies from the Bailey's Shelter; Fellowship Hall, 9:30 am

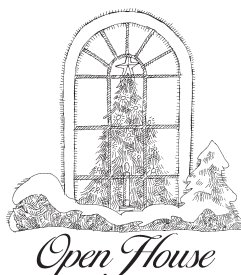
