Deuteronomy 6:5-7 (NIV) counsels us to "love the Lord your God with all your heart ..., [to keep] these commandments ... [on] your hearts ... [to] [i]mpress them on your children ... [t]alk about them when you sit

at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up." Jesus modeled this. Loving God means making Him and His word an important part of our lives, pursuing Him and His will for our lives urgently. Some of us come from loving households that pursue God perhaps less urgently than these verses suggest, but now we are called to chart a new path, one that follows Jesus.

Step one is to become more familiar with God and His word. Sometimes we cannot rush change and need to move at a pace we can handle. Changing one's life takes time, commitment and patience. Studying the word of God may feel uncomfortable initially, but doing so is right.

To help with this, there will be a new Essentials class, at a different time from our Bible classes. The focus of the class is newer Christians and anyone else who wants to improve their study of God and His word. This class will meet once a month, on the LAST Sunday of each month, AFTER the morning assembly, during lunch, to be more convenient to attend. You may bring your own lunch, or we'll order out. Babysitting will be available. This Essentials class will last into next year. Our first meeting will be on the last Sunday of this month, March 29.

Studying God's word makes us wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. 2 Tim 3:15-17. Please pray that God will fill us "with the knowledge of his will through all spiritual wisdom and understanding. ... that [we] ... may please him in every way: bearing fruit ..., [and] growing in the knowledge of God ...." Col. 1:9-10. Please pray about this class and those who are considering it. Your encouragement would also be greatly appreciated.

We don't want to be different from our friends, coworkers or team mates. This is where the strength and courage we receive from the Holy Spirt helps us.

This is also where the trials and struggles of living out our faith happen most but that is another article!
