Our annual Ice Cream Social will take place TODAY, August 9, after the evening assembly. This will be our 2nd Sunday Fellowship Event for this month.

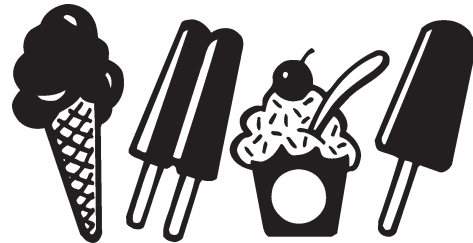
If at all possible - please bring a container of HOME-MADE ice cream. Any flavor is just fine!

Toppings like chocolate syrup, hot fudge sauce, caramel sauce, butterscotch, strawberry syrup, etc.



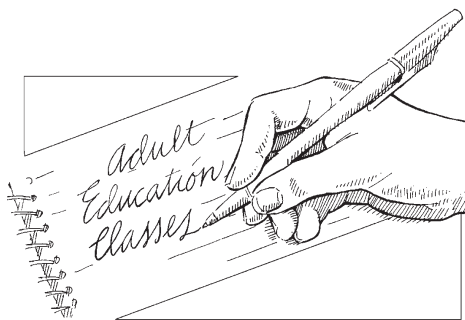
## ICE CREAM SOCIAL
