Falls Church Member Will Run in 5K Race to Raise Funds for MMRF

Anna Souza is participating in a 5K race on Nov. 15 at National Harbor to benefit the Multiple Myeloma Research Foundation. Her race will start at 9:15 am.



This is in memory of her brother **Jesse Souza** who passed away earlier this year after a battle with the incurable cancer. He was just 32.

The foundation was established in 1998 and since then has raised over \$278 million, of which 90% is directed to research and related programs. It has received a “Best in America” Seal of Excellence from the Independent Charities of America, an “A+” rating from the American Institute of Philanthropy, and has been recognized by Philanthrope-dia as a nonprofit in the field of cancer.

Anna is heading “Team Jesse” to honor the former Marine who served in Operation Iraqi Freedom, and who worked with the Gwinnett Sheriff’s Department as a deputy sheriff. As a Marine Reservist, he helped in the clean up after Hurricane Katrina.
