# **SNOW**



We all just survived a huge snowstorm/blizzard and in the wake of that storm everything is covered in over 18 inches of snow! This white blanket covers everything the same; the streets, the sidewalks, our yards and even our cars. All the blemishes are covered by an 18 inch layer or white.

On Sunday morning we had a small home devotional in which we all reflected on this snow - thinking about what we can learn or see by comparing the snow and the LORD.

One thought that came up was how the LORD's love covers us just like the snow. The snow lays a new clean layer on which to build something new. When we accept the LORD's love and follow His way we have the opportunity to start new. The snow is like the forgiveness we find in our

LORD JESUS CHRIST. This forgiveness covers the flaws or sins in our lives. The temptations of those flaws and sins are still present but the LORD's forgiveness covers them. The forgiveness we receive opens us to the Holy Spirit and the Spirit gives us the strength to overcome the temptations we face.

At least twice in the book of Revelation (Rev. 7.14 & 22.14) we read about people who wash their robes in the blood of the Lamb. Their robes go from dirty and stained with sin to being pure white. This transformation is not done with strong industrial bleach but with the Blood of the Lamb. We know from personal experience that blood stains and doesn't make them white. Once again the LORD does something unexpected.

Just as snow covers and blankets the landscape, so the Lamb's blood covers and blankets our life. I hope and pray that if you haven't you will reflect on this truth and become one of us who have been washed in the Blood of the Lamb.
