**Falls Church Members:**

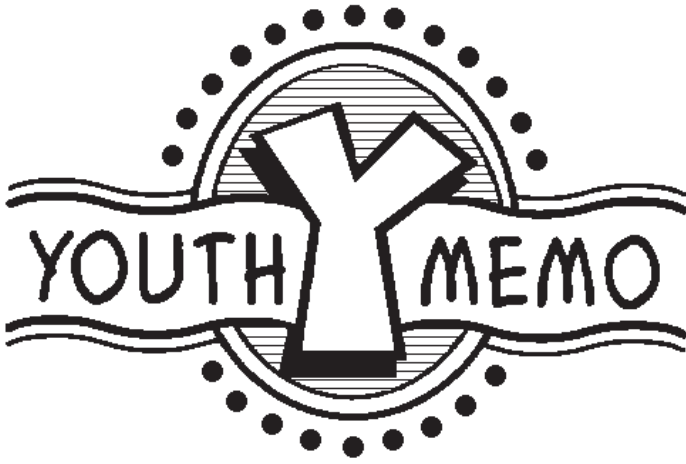
It's not too late to contribute to the Disaster Relief Effort collection.
