There are numerous projects to be done, each with varying level of skills required - see list below - and your help is really needed. Feel free to drop by anytime during the day to help.

Breakfast will be served starting at 8 am and work will begin at 8:30 am. Lunch also will be provided for all workers.

FIRST FLOOR

Vacuum Fellowship Hall (after meals are served)
Vacuum hallways
Clean Fellowship Hall windows inside and outside
Clean white interior doors (restrooms, boiler room, kitchen, etc)
Clean restroom mirrors
Sweep and mop restroom floors
Clean tile walls in restrooms
Straighten up shelves over coatrack outside FH
Sweep and mop floor of stairwell from FH to auditorium

SECOND FLOOR

Vacuum all carpet in auditorium
Dust and spot clean if needed all pews
Sweep under pews
Clean baptistry glass
Sweep and mop communion preparation room
Vacuum foyer and hallways
Clean foyer windows
Clean glass foyer doors (inside and outside)
Straighten up coat closet
Straighten up toy room
Vacuum all class rooms including nursery
Sweep and mop restroom floors, including nursery restroom
Clean tile walls in restrooms
Vacuum carpet in Ladies Lounge & Nursing Mother's Room
Clean all restroom mirrors

THIRD FLOOR

Vacuum hallways
Vacuum all classrooms, including Spanish worship room
Vacuum main stairwell
Sweep and mop all restroom floors
Clean all restroom mirrors
Clean all restroom tile walls
Sweep and mop baptistry floors
Clean baptistry toilets as necessary
Sweep and mop floor outside baptistry and stairwell
Find a place to store the quarterround moulding

Dispose of TV and other trash in stairwell closest to parking lot

Dispose of wood desk in hallway

(2 items above may require a truck and run to the dump)

OUTSIDE

Clean out FH entry
Restack loose landscaping stones near center ground entrance
Sweep landings and steps on both sides of foyer
Straighten up and sweep out A/C chiller area
Trim or poison any weeds growing under chiller fence
Remove any trash from shrubbery beds around the building
Trimming trees around the building and the ones that line the yard and walks up to the building
[NOTE: A pressure washer to clean sidewalks would be deeply appreciated.]
