10th Annual Church Picnic Planned for Tomorrow, July 4 at Bluemont Park

10:45-11 am - everyone come with assigned food items

In short, there's simply not a more convenient spot for a picnic or a better group of people to picnic with!

Below are the Agape Group items to bring/duties to perform; notice that ALL GROUPS are asked to join in the clean up. PLUS, mayo, mustard, ketchup & relish will be provided!

IN ADDITION, organizers **Dana & Kelvin Hatcher** need someone with a pick-up truck - or similarly large transport - to pick up the grill and some tables at the church building, haul them to the park, unload them and, after the event, reverse course.

Central - ****clean up****

- green salads and dressing
- 60 pcs of lettuce washed, torn & ready to use in a Ziploc bag
- desserts
- juice boxes (on ice)
- soda (on ice)

South - ****clean up****

- 120 individual bags of chips
- dips
- pre cut fruit trays
- bottled water (on ice)
- Gatorade (on ice)

Eastern ****set up & clean up****

- desserts
- onions 5 lg onions sliced & 5 lg onions diced (in doubled-up Ziploc bags since they tend to smell)
- 60 slices of tomato (in a Ziploc bag)
- 5 medium jars of sliced pickles

West ****clean up****

- 2 lg cans of baked beans - can be in 2 crockpots
- 60 pcs of lettuce; washed, torn, and ready to use; bring in a Ziploc bag
- cold salads - potato, macaroni, bean, etc...

Spanish ****clean up****

In Memoriam

Our brother **James S. Petty** passed away May 12, 2016, at the age of 94. He is shown at right with his wife **Louise Underhill Petty**, who died Jan. 2, 1998, at the age of 78. He was born Jan. 22, 1922, and she was born Dec. 27, 1920. Both are buried in Union Cemetery in Dickson, TN, west of Nashville.

They placed membership here Sept. 8, 1962. Jim's health declined in recent years and he no longer was able to attend worship service. But he and Louise left a legacy of love. Jim grew roses, abundant roses all around their home, and he & Louise arranged and transported the fragrant flowers to patients in Fairfax Hospital. In fact, Louise was known as the Rose Lady of Fairfax, and was the object of an article in The Washington Post.

Both of them were known for their outgoing personalities, their generosity of spirit and their time, and their sense of humor. Jim also was a WWII veteran who survived a plane crash on an island in the Pacific. He worked many years for Voice of America, was a member of the Masons, and participated in charitable work in the community. They were well loved and deeply respected.
