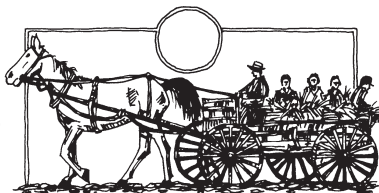
Children should wear their costumes and bring a bag to carry home the loot.

These days teens don't make mixtapes - they make playlists and share those lists with friends. The purpose is the same but the format has changed.









- Why would someone put this song on an inspirational playlist/mixtape?
- How does this song challenge you?
- How does this song encourage you?
- What is the message of this song?
- What scriptural message/echos do you hear in this song?

The goal of this series is to equip our teens and students to be active listeners to the media they consume. Rather than passively listen to or watching whatever is on they will ask questions and discover if media they are consuming is healthy or not.
