is the ONLY day you have, so make sure you get your "so long" wishes down in print!


We will add their family photo to the frame and give it to them just before they head out!

## Winterfest 2017: Identity - Who Are You?

"But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy." (1 Peter 2.9 - .10)

Finding our identity in Christ as a Holy Nation

Last Sunday night many of our teens and students participated in a panel to talk about their Winterfest 2017 experience. They talked about the fun memories they had from the bus trip, hanging out in Gatlinburg and just being together. They shared what they learned and how this trip has helped them. They also told us why someone should come on this trip. I want to thank them for sharing in front of everyone that night.

Being holy has very little to do with our behavior. We can't make ourselves holy. We can think and behave in holy ways but only the LORD can make us holy. Being holy means we are set aside or specially chosen by the LORD.

When the LORD calls us to be a Holy Nation, the LORD is bringing together peoples who have been separated. We live in a culture that wants to divide and separate people, but the Holy Nation the LORD is creating wants to draw people together.

From the earliest days of the church we have been drawing culturally, ethnically and economically divided people together. Many of the issues the letters of Paul, Peter, James, John and Jude write have sections that deal with uniting divided peoples. As a Holy Nation our allegiance shifts from an earthly nation to the Heavenly Kingdom. Our king is not elected or selected - our KING is the LORD. We no longer live as citizens of this culture or nation but we live as citizens of the Kingdom of Heaven.

Finding our identity in Jesus as a Holy Nation other than the nation we live in is just one of the many radical changes the LORD brings to our lives!
