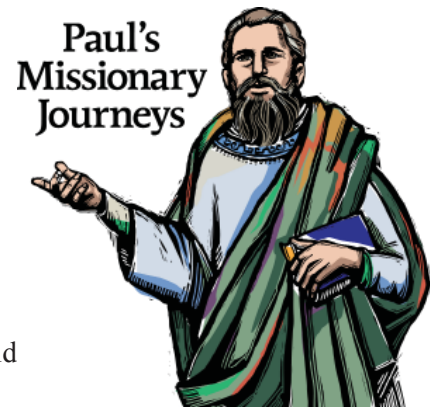

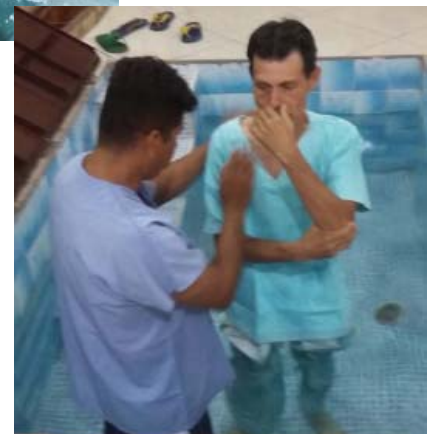
Lourdes Auxiliadora Tellez also was baptized on April 7
